BACKGROUND

SUMMARY

Michigan implemented a naloxone standing order in 2017. It allowed people to get naloxone, a drug that can reverse an opioid overdose, at participating pharmacies without a prescription.

The stakeholder survey was part of a policy evaluation of the standing order. The survey asked members of the Kent County Opioid Task Force to rate the impact of and barriers related to the standing order.

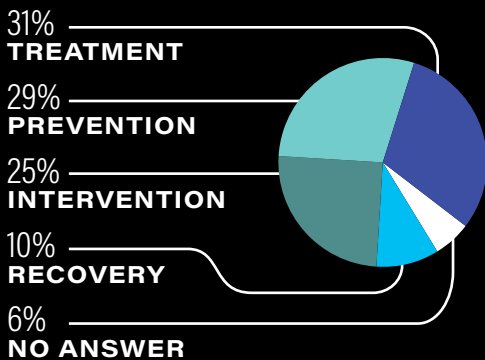

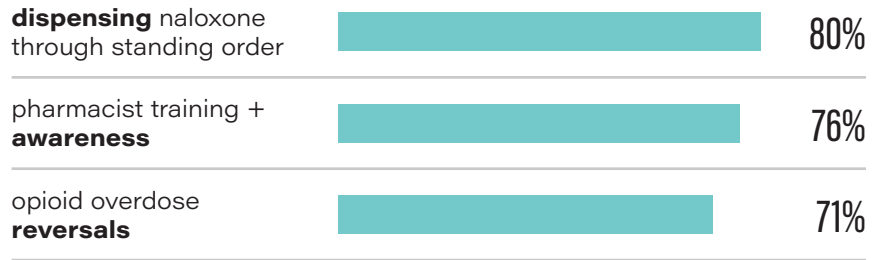

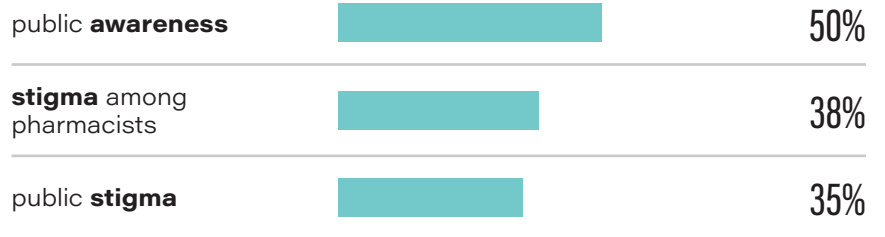
